The market will be located at 35 Lincoln Ave. (behind the Spiegel Community Center) on Saturdays from 9am-1pm. We plan to continue the legacy of our family-friendly market, including live music and modified kids activities, by implementing realistic yet effective safety measures.

We take standards for hygiene and cleanliness very seriously and will be taking steps to ensure the safety of our shoppers and vendors. We have been closely monitoring the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), World Health Organization (WHO), and Local Regulations regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19). Our planned health and safety measures are designed to ensure a safe environment that still allows for an enjoyable vendor and shopper experience.

Safety Guidelines for Shoppers and Vendors

- Please only attend the market if you are feeling well. If you're sick, please stay home until symptoms subside.
- Both shoppers and vendors are required to wear a mask or facial covering.
- Both shoppers and vendors are required to maintain social distancing, which will be facilitated by limiting the market to no more than 200 people at a time.
- Vendors are required to wear, and regularly change, gloves.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be provided throughout the market for shopper and vendor use.
